<i>Carex lacustris</i>	common lake sedge ; hairy sedge
<i>Carex pellita</i>	brown-leaf woolly sedge ; woolly sedge
<i>Carex sartwellii</i>	Sartwell's sedge ; running marsh sedge
<i>Carex stipata</i>	common fox sedge ; owl-fruit sedge
<i>Carex tetanica</i>	stiff sedge ; rigid sedge
<i>Cirsium muticum</i>	swamp thistle
<i>Cypripedium reginae</i>	showy lady-slipper
<i>Dryopteris carthusiana</i>	spinulose wood fern ; spinulose shield fern
<i>Equisetum fluviatile</i>	water horsetail ; river horsetail
<i>Equisetum hyemale</i> ssp. <i>affine</i>	scouring-rush horsetail ; tall scouring-rush
<i>Gentianopsis procera</i>	lesser fringed gentian ; lesser felwort
<i>Juniperus virginiana</i>	eastern red-cedar
<i>Lysimachia quadriflora</i>	prairie loosestrife ; four-flower loosestrife
<i>Matteuccia struthiopteris</i> var. <i>pennsylvanica</i>	ostrich fern
<i>Onoclea sensibilis</i>	sensitive fern
<i>Parnassia glauca</i>	American grass-of-parnassus ; fen grass-of-parnassua
<i>Pedicularis lanceolata</i>	swamp lousewort
<i>Potamogeton zosteriformis</i>	flat-stem pondweed
<i>Rubus pubescens</i>	dwarf red blackberry ; dwarf red raspberry
<i>Salix candida</i>	sage-leaf willow ; sage willow
<i>Symphyotrichum boreale</i>	northern bog aster ; rush aster
<i>Symphyotrichum firmum</i>	purple-stem aster
