<i>Erysimum cheiranthoides</i>	worm-seed mustard ; worm-seed wallflower
<i>Euphorbia marginata</i>	snow-on-the-mountain
<i>Helianthus giganteus</i>	giant sunflower ; swamp sunflower
<i>Helianthus tuberosus</i>	Jerusalem-artichoke ; woodland sunflower
<i>Rudbeckia laciniata</i> var. <i>laciniata</i>	cut-leaf coneflower ; green-head coneflower
<i>Silphium perfoliatum</i> var. <i>perfoliatum</i>	cup plant
<i>Solidago altissima</i>	late goldenrod
<i>Solidago canadensis</i>	Canada goldenrod
<i>Solidago flexicaulis</i>	zigzag goldenrod
<i>Solidago nemoralis</i> ssp. <i>decemflora</i>	gray goldenrod
<i>Solidago rigida</i>	stiff goldenrod
<i>Symphotrichum drummondii</i>	Drummond's aster ; hairy heart-leaf aster
<i>Symphotrichum ericoides</i>	frost aster ; white heath aster
<i>Symphotrichum ericoides</i> var. <i>ericoides</i>	frost aster ; white heath aster
<i>Symphotrichum laeve</i> var. <i>laeve</i>	smooth blue aster
<i>Symphotrichum lanceolatum</i> var. <i>lanceolatum</i>	white panicle aster ; eastern lined aster
<i>Trillium nivale</i>	snow trillium ; dwarf trillium
