<i>Scirpus cyperinus</i>	wool-grass ; cotton-grass bulrush
<i>Scutellaria lateriflora</i>	mad-dog skullcap
<i>Sium suave</i>	hemlock water-parsnip
<i>Solanum dulcamara</i>	deadly nightshade ; climbing nightshade
<i>Sonchus arvensis</i> ssp. <i>uliginosus</i>	field sow-thistle ; perennial sow-thistle
<i>Spartina pectinata</i>	prairie cordgrass ; santu'hu tan'ka
<i>Symphotrichum lateriflorum</i>	calico aster ; goblet aster
<i>Trifolium repens</i>	white clover
<i>Utricularia vulgaris</i>	greater bladderwort ; common bladderwort
